

Subject: Notification of Retroactive Billing for Medical Services Provided by non-Fixed Medical Facilities in the U.S. Central Command Area of Responsibility

The attached Director, Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy memorandum advises that billing for medical treatment has been implemented by the Defense Finance and Accounting Service for contractors supporting U.S. Forces in Southwest Asia. Initial billings for medical treatments were processed from February 2011 and forward. Retroactive billing for medical treatments that occurred from October 2007 through February 2011 will be processed by December 31, 2011.



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SUBJECT: Notification of Retroactive Billing for Medical Services Provided by non-Fixed
Medical Facilities in the U.S. Central Command Area of Responsibility

In accordance with Title 10 of the United States Code §1079b, "Procedures for charging fees for care provided to civilians; retention and use of fees collected," the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) has implemented a billing process for contractors supporting U.S. Forces in Southwest Asia. The initial billings were for medical treatments occurring from February 2011 and forward. However, the U.S. Code is applicable to all medical treatments provided in Southwest Asia. As a result, DFAS will perform retroactive billings for medical treatments occurring from October 2007 through February 2011, by December 31, 2011. Normal billings will then resume for medical treatments provided to patients on a routine basis.
