
SUBJECT: Follow-up to Energy Evaluation Factors in the Acquisition Process

This memorandum is a follow-up to the tasking and guidance found in the Memorandum "Energy Evaluation Factors in the Acquisition Process" dated June 20 2011, concerning the use of energy-related factors in acquisition planning, trade-off analyses, technology development, and competitive source selections for platforms and weapons systems. As stated in the June 20th memo, a future memorandum will provide guidance on energy related factors in non-tactical shore operations.

All System Commands (SYSCOMS) met the tasking presented in the June 20th memo to develop a uniform method for calculating FBCE to support their respective acquisition programs. These respective methods have been reviewed and approved by the office of ASN (RD&A). They should be applied to each of your programs going forward, and will be reflected in the PoPs (Version 2.2) update.
